### **Annual Special Camp Report 2023-2024**

The NSS Unit of APS College of Arts and Science conducted a 7-day annual special camp at Ramanamaharushi Blind centre, Tirumurthy Village Development Center, Jakkasandra, Kanakapura Taluk, Ramanagara District, from April 15-21, 2024. This camp aimed to inculcate values of community service, social responsibility, and environmental protection among NSS volunteers.

#### **Inaugural Ceremony**

The inaugural ceremony was held on April 15, 2024, at 5:00 pm. Retired pharmacist of Kidwai Hospital, Yashoda was the chief guest. She appreciated the college management and the convener for selecting this place for the camp in which selfless service and mentoring for the mentally and physically challenged children can be done for a whole week. She also mentioned about Mother Teresa whose dedication and compassion to the society fetched her Nobel Prize. Principal Prof. B. Jayashree presided over the program. In her address, Prof. Jayashree emphasized the importance of selfless service and environmental protection, inspiring the NSS volunteers to make a positive impact on society.

#### **Camp Activities**

Over the next seven days, NSS volunteers participated in a range of activities designed to promote community service, social responsibility, and environmental protection. These activities included:

Every day morning at 6.00 am flag hoisting was done by local representatives and in the evening, lowering ceremonies was conducted with a great sense of national pride and unity.

Every day after the breakfast Shramadan (community service) projects such as cleaning and maintenance of the center's facilities like cleaning the tanks and surroundings was done to promote teamwork and social responsibility.

After the Shramadan Special lectures were conducted which broadened the volunteers' knowledge and understanding of the critical issues. Some of the sessions were as follows:

**Day 2:-** A special lecture was conducted on the role of youth in environmental protection by Mrs. Vasanthi K., retired associate professor of VVN College who said it is the right and duty of all the youth to protect the environment and to make good use of renewable resources and protect them for the next generation.

**Day 3:-** A practical session on yoga was demonstrated by Shri Prabhayaswamy, a retired police officer who arrived as a resource person and spoke about the idea of yoga for good health and also showcased many asanas.

**Day 4:-** A talk on the values and importance of constitution was organized by resource person, Shri Kiran Raj, General Secretary of Jet Public School Kanakapura. He spoke on the topic of the Constitution of India and the Political Code.

**Day 5:-** Shri C.V. Devaraj, Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, Kanakapura Rural College, was the resource person for the session. He spoke on the topics like social service, personality development and family values.

**Day 6:-** A special lecture program was conducted by Dr. Krishnamurthy, Head of the Department of Sociology and Program Officer of Vijaya College, Bangalore. 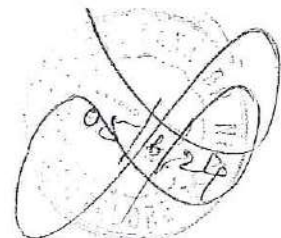

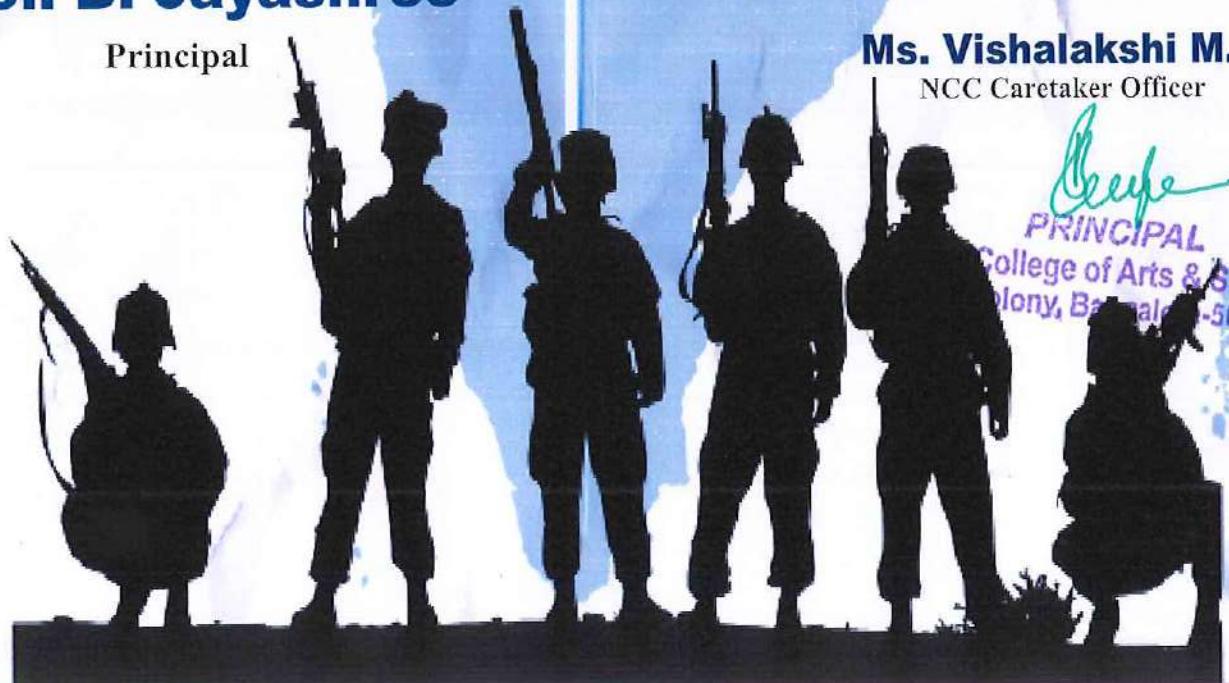

## Report on Kargil Vijay Diwas
