Best Practice 1

- 1. Title of the Practice: Health check-up and awareness programs for the students and faculty
- 2. The Objective: The objective is to raise awareness about sound mind in a sound body. Students are sensitized mainly on wellbeing, its impact on their studies and also about need of regular health check-up. Address adolescence issues.
- 3. The Context: Students suffer from various health related issues that require personal diagnosis and treatment. Students particularly from weak economic background are initially reluctant to share their personal and health related issues which hamper their mental and academic growth and also proper decision making and overall personality development.
- 4. The Practice: Health check-up for students a unique practice initiated by the college is done every semester and it has proved to be highly beneficial. All students and faculty were screened by doctors and had a one-to-one discussion regarding personal issues related to girl students. Free medical check up and awareness programs for girl students was organised about the common issues faced by them and about maintaining overall health.
- 5. Evidence of Success: Some evidence of success of the practice includes cheerfulness, healthy, improved attendance, and academic progress, participation in co-curricular and extracurricular activities. The students were found completely relaxed. They were seen to progress in academics and further, their increasing participation in extra-curricular activities is vindication of this initiative. Students were also seen progressing through higher education in the form of enrolment in PG courses.
- 6. Problems encountered and resource required: Some of the students felt reluctant to express their personal health-related problems freely. To overcome this, counselling through senior staff was adopted and this move was encouraging. College has collaborated with NGOs and voluntary organizations in organizing the health check-up, who voluntarily came forward to arrange health check-up camps by bringing expert medical professionals from well-known hospitals.

Pranayama helped them develop a focused mind and keep mental equilibrium. The results were visible with the students; they gained much confidence and their concentration in class increased after the yoga practice.

6. Problems encountered and resource required:

Some students struggled to focus due to various distractions, and many were not consistent in attending the sessions due to a lack of awareness about the benefits of yoga. However, the resources required for yoga were minimal, as the yoga mats were provided by the APS Trust, and the institution is well-equipped with the necessary infrastructure to conduct the classes.



The event successfully raised awareness about the importance of blood and blood donation, promoting a healthy lifestyle among students. A total of 55 units of blood were collected.









REPORT ON WORLD MENSTRUAL HYGIENE DAY

The Women Empowerment Cell and Health Club of APS College of Arts and Science in collaboration with Campus Konnect (Brand Touch and Analytics Pvr.Ltd), organized a comprehensive soft skills and Hygiene training session dedicated to girl students on the occasion of Menstrual Hygiene Day on May 30th, 2024. The program aimed to educate and empower female students regarding health, hygiene, and the importance of self-care during menstruation. This initiative saw active participation from approximately 230 girl students from both the APS PU and APS college of Arts and Science.

OBJECTIVES:

- Raising awareness about menstruation and breaking the taboo and stigma associated with it.

The highlights of the training were to create Self-Branding .She emphasized on the significance of personal hygiene as part of one's self-brand. Building confidence and self-esteem through proper self-care practices.

The session witnessed enthusiastic participation from the students, who engaged actively in the discussions and interactive segments of the training. The students expressed their gratitude for the valuable insights provided by the trainers and acknowledged the importance of the knowledge gained.

- The Course Certificates is value addition to their educational enrichment.



The Postgraduate Studies in Economics (M.A.) organized a one-day seminar on "Concepts and Strategies for Crafting a Compelling Dissertation" on 12th June 2024. The seminar aimed to enhance the skills needed for conceptualizing and executing project work using data analytical tools for final year M.A. students.

Objectives:

- 1. To provide insights into the structure and components of a dissertation.
- 2. To equip students with strategies for selecting relevant research topics.
- 3. To guide students in developing robust research methodologies.
- 4. To expose students to various AI & ML tools for writing dissertation.
- 5. To enhance students' skills in writing, formatting, and presenting their dissertations.

The resource person, Sri. Chandramouleshwara M., Assistant Professor, PG Department of Economics, shared his insights on using AI & ML tools for dissertation writing, emphasizing the importance of clear concepts and strategic approaches.

The seminar began with an explanation of the significance of choosing a research topic that aligns with both academic relevance and personal interest. The resource person discussed the essential components of a dissertation, including:

- Introduction
- Literature Review
- Research Methodology
- Data Analysis
- Conclusion and Recommendations

He provided practical examples to illustrate the role of each section in the dissertation process. The seminar also covered various qualitative and quantitative research methods, with a strong emphasis on selecting appropriate methodologies and tools for data collection and analysis.

In the afternoon session, Mrs. Satyashree, Associate professor, Department of computer Science, introduced the use of technology, including Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) tools in crafting dissertations. The resource person highlighted how AI tools


can assist in literature review automation, data analysis, and citation management. Specific examples included tools like Perplexity AI for generating research ideas, Gamma AI for creating presentations, Meta's AI tools for analysing large datasets, and Quill bot for paraphrasing and enhancing writing. These tools were demonstrated to show their practical applications, encouraged students to leverage advanced technologies to improve the efficiency and quality of their project work.

Students actively participated in the interactive Q&A session, seeking clarification on doubts regarding topic selection, methodology, data analysis techniques, and the integration of technology in their project work.

- 1. **Improved Understanding:** Students demonstrated a clear understanding of the dissertation structure, components, and research methodologies.
- 2. Enhanced Research Skills: Students gained the ability to identify and select relevant research topics, develop research questions, and design a research methodology.
- 3. **Increased Confidence:** Students exhibited increased confidence in their ability to write and present their dissertations.
- 4. **Technological Proficiency:** Students recognized the potential of AI and ML tools in enhancing the quality and efficiency of their dissertations.

The seminar concluded with positive feedback from the participants, who expressed their appreciation for the practical insights and technological guidance provided during the seminar.
